

## **Patch Fees:**

ALL skaters must purchase patch cards from the skate shop. Please plan ahead as the skate shop is not open in the morning.

You must be a SAFSA member in order to purchase a patch card.

Each session you skate in MUST be signed off by a coach regardless of whether you are having a lesson or not, or for how long you are on the ice.

Some patches have been grouped together into a single **patch group** for your benefit.

Each patch group needs to be signed off by a coach. A patch is regarded as follows:

- **Monday, Tuesday, Thursday**
  - **05:00am – 12:30pm** (classed as one patch with a Zamboni break in between)
  - **01:00pm – 04:30pm** (classed as one patch)
  - **04:45pm – onwards** (classed as one patch) (evenings)
- **Wednesday**
  - **10:00am – 12:30pm** (classed as one patch)
  - **01:00pm – 04:30pm** (Classed as one patch)
  - **04:45pm – onwards** (classed as one patch) (evenings)
- **Friday**
  - **10:00am – 12:30pm** (classed as one patch)
  - **01:00pm – 04:30pm** (classed as one patch)
- **Saturday**
  - **05:00am – 08:00am** (Classed as one patch)

PLEASE ensure that your patch card is signed off in EVERY session you take part in. It is the responsibility of the skater.

**Please leave the card there for the duration of your practice. Ensure that your coach has signed the card before you leave the ice, and take your card with you. Should you owe more than six patches, you will not be allowed onto the ice.**
